Outdoor activities are free, and tickets for indoor performances go on sale February 16 at 10 a.m. at Ordway.org/Festival.

The phenomenal headliners bring an exciting energy for the entire festival. <u>Salsa del Soul</u> is a Twin Cities-based, nine-piece orchestra performing various styles of dance music from the Spanish-speaking regions of the Caribbean; their music will have all generations dancing together in the street. <u>The String Queens</u> is a dynamic trio that creates stimulating musical experiences that inspire diverse audiences to love, hope, feel and imagine! <u>Lastly, KOO KOO KANGA ROO</u> is made up of two guys who met in college, started a band and now are touring with their catchy songs, comedy and dance music for crowds large and small.
